NVQ Level 2 in Childcare Learning and Development is a nationally recognised qualification accredited by a national awarding body that will enable learners to gain a qualification that relates directly to the Nursery Nurse environment. The course will enhance the learners personal growth and development and so enable them to undertake the children’s care role with greater confidence.

→ What will I learn on this course?

Course Content:

The level 2 qualification contains six mandatory units and a total of four optional units. In order to achieve the full NVQ at level 2 candidates must undertake all six mandatory units plus one optional unit

Mandatory Units:

- ⇒ CCLD 201 Contribute to positive relationships
- ⇒ CCLD 202 Help to keep children safe
- ⇒ CCLD 203 Support children’s development
- ⇒ CCLD 204 Use support to develop own practice in children’s care, learning and development
- ⇒ CCLD 205 Prepare and maintain environments to meet children’s needs
- ⇒ CCLD 206 Support children’s play and learning

Optional Units:

- ⇒ CCLD 207 Contribute to the effectiveness of teams
- ⇒ CCLD 208 Support the development of babies and children under 3 years
- ⇒ CCLD 209 Support a child with disabilities or special educational needs
- ⇒ CCLD 210 Support children and young people’s play

Course delivery and assessment:

You will be allocated an assessor who will assess you in your work place by observing you carry out your daily tasks and duties. You will be required to answer written/ oral questions and record what you do at work. There are no final exams, this NVQ is completely coursework assessed.

Please note:

On completion of the NVQ L2 in Children’s Care the learner will become a qualified Nursery worker, they can then potentially progress onto Children’s Care NVQ L3.
